

Supplier Code of Conduct

1. Introduction

This code sets out the principles of conduct and ethical standards that suppliers of ELEKTRO – LUMEN, s.r.o. must adhere to. Our goal is to cooperate only with partners who share our values in the areas of quality, environment, sustainability, safety and responsible business.

2. Compliance with laws and regulations

The supplier is obliged to:

- Comply with all applicable laws and standards relating to production, safety, labour law, environmental protection and data protection.
- Fulfill obligations arising from legislation relating to electrical equipment (e.g. CE marking, RoHS, WEEE).

3. Ethical working conditions

The supplier must:

- Ensure decent working conditions, equal opportunities and a safe environment without discrimination.
- Do not use child labour, forced labour or any form of abuse.
- Respect the rights of employees to fair remuneration, rest and freedom of association.

4. Product quality and safety

The supplier undertakes to:

- Supply products that meet the specified specifications, norms and quality standards.
- Ensure electrical safety, luminous efficiency, environmental compatibility and long service life of the luminaires.
- Regularly test and inspect its products according to the requirements of the contracting authority or harmonised standards.

5. Environmental protection

The supplier is obliged to:

- Minimise the negative impacts of production on the environment (emissions, energy consumption, waste).
- Prioritise recyclable materials and energy-saving technologies.
- Comply with environmental standards, in particular in accordance with RoHS (safe materials) and WEEE (return of electrical equipment).

6. Business ethics

The supplier must not:

- Offer or accept bribes, benefits or other forms of corruption.
- Enter into conflicts of interest without prior notification.
- Misuse confidential information or infringe intellectual property protection.



7. Transparency and Audit

- The Supplier is required to maintain relevant records and documentation.
- It must allow for an audit or inspection upon request if there is a reasonable suspicion of a violation of the Code or other rules.
- Provide full cooperation in the investigation and correction of any deficiencies.

8. Reporting Mechanisms

- The Supplier is required to establish or respect channels for anonymous reporting of unethical or illegal behavior.
- Whistleblowers must be protected from any form of retaliation.

9. Consequences of Violation

Violation of this Code may result in:

- Warnings and corrective actions
- Suspension or termination of cooperation
- Reporting of serious violations to the appropriate authorities
